Rugby

Rugby is played by two teams of 15 players, using an oval (egg-shaped) ball which is kicked or (21) Players can throw it backwards or sideways, but they cannot throw it forwards. They can, however, kick it forwards.

The (22) of the game is to score more points than the other team. There are two ways to score. The first is by touching the (23) behind the other team's goal line with the ball. This is worth five points. The player who scored can earn a (24) two points by kicking the ball over the H-shaped goal. Players can also try to score goals during the game, or if they are given a penalty. These goals are worth three points.

It is dangerous because the players on the other team stop the player with the ball by making him fall. The (25) of the game were written in 1845 by schoolboys who (26) Rugby School in England.

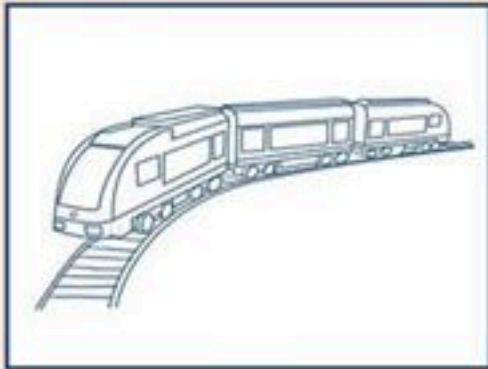
