WM: Oh yes! Who's that? The boy with the ball.

BOY: His name's Nick. He's kicking a ball! Nick loves football.

WM: That's good.

(pause) 3 seconds

R: Can you see the line? This is an example. Now you listen and draw lines. (pause) 3 seconds

R: One

WM: There are two girls here; one is standing and one is sitting on the street. Who's the girl in the brown boots?

BOY: Is she wearing a red dress?

BOY: And the girl next to Alice is Jill.

WM: Is Jill reading a book?

BOY: Yes! She loves reading.

WM: So do I!

BOY: Yes, that's Tom's dog.

WM: Is Tom sitting next to the dog?

BOY: Yes, that's right. He's looking at him.

(pause) 5 seconds

WM: Who's the boy with the skateboard?

BOY: Is this boy wearing a hat?

WM: Yes.

BOY: That's my friend Dan. Skateboarding is Dan's favourite hobby.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Five

WM: And what's that boy's name? He's running.

BOY: Has he got black hair or brown hair?

WM: Oh! He's got black hair.

BOY: His name's Matt. Matt is very funny.

(pause) 5 seconds

BOY: Yes, it's nice to have good friends.

(pause) 10 seconds

R: Four

WM: Has Alex got a friend?

BOY: Yes. His friend's name is Sue.

WM: How do you spell that?

BOY: S-U-E.

(pause) 10 seconds

R: Five

WM: What can Alex do?

BOY: He can write numbers.

WM: How many numbers can he write?

BOY: Fifteen.

WM: Sorry? Fifteen?

BOY: That's right.

(pause) 10 seconds

R: Now listen to Part 2 again. PAUSE 00'03"
[REPEAT PART 2 WITH ONLY 00'05" PAUSES]

BOY: No, I can't see a boat.

MAN: Can you see a spider?

BOY: No. I can see a shell.

R: Two. What is May doing?

(pause) 3 seconds

WM: Is May in the kitchen, Kim?

GIRL: No, she's in the living room.

WM: Is she drawing a picture?

GIRL: No, she's singing.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Three. What is Jill playing with?

(pause) 3 seconds

MAN: What are you playing with, Jill? Is it a frog or a crocodile?

GIRL: No, it's not green like them.

MAN: Oh, well. Is it a giraffe?

GIRL: Yes, it is.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Four. What is Ben having for breakfast?

(pause) 3 seconds

WM: Ben, do you want a banana or a mango for breakfast?

MAN: A mango. Can I have some juice?

WM: We haven't got any juice. Do you want some milk?

MAN: OK.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Five. What sport does Pat want to play?

(pause) 3 seconds

MAN: Pat, do you want to play tennis?

GIRL: No, not today.

MAN: Well, do you want to play football?

GIRL: No, let's play basketball.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Now listen to Part 3 again. PAUSE 00'03"
[REPEAT PART 3 WITH NO PAUSE AFTER THE QUESTION BUT THE SAME 00'05" PAUSE AFTER EACH DIALOGUE]

MAN: Yes, you can.

GIRL: OK. The cat between the piano and the bookcase is purple.

MAN: That's right. Colour that cat brown.

GIRL: Which colour?

MAN: Brown. The cat sitting on the toy cow.

GIRL: That's my cousin Mark. Swimming is Mark's favourite hobby.

GIRL: His name's Alex. Alex likes fishing.

MAN: Me too!

GIRL: I like swimming; not fishing!

MAN: What are you having for lunch, Sue? Is it chicken?

GIRL: No, it's not. It's fish.

MAN: And have you got an apple or an orange?

GIRL: An orange.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Four. Which is Tom's sister?

(pause) 3 seconds

WM: Tom, is your sister the girl with the short hair?

BOY: No, she has long hair.

WM: Is she wearing a pink hat?

BOY: Yes.

(pause) 5 seconds

R: Five. What's the teacher doing?

(pause) 3 seconds

BOY: May, what's the teacher doing? Is she writing on the board?

GIRL: No, she's not.

BOY: Well, is she eating lunch?

GIRL: No, she's reading the children a story.

(pause) 5 seconds
